TtEmail - Database Driven Email

TeraTech, Inc has released ttEmail. This program allows a company that already has a networked database up and running to send email simply by making a new record in a database table. Anyone with access to the database can send an email. Great for sales applications that require instant email responses. For DB programmers, ttEmail allows email to send automatically when certain database-triggered events occur. Also great for sending out bulk email from your database. ttEmail can be set to send email as soon as the record is created, or to check for outgoing email on a custom schedule. The return address can be any address you like. TtEmail does not currently handle email attachments.
